- Leftover meat, fish, shell fish

- Dust, vacuum cleaner bags
- Nappies/diapers, sanitary towels and pads
- Bottle caps
- Ice cream sticks, chopsticks
- Wax candles
- Dirt, plants, cut flowers
- Snus, cigarettes, ashes
- Soup, drinks, sauces

Tips and advice

Biological treatment converts food waste to biogas, biofertiliser or compost soil. Biogas can, for example, be used to run cars and buses, while biofertilisers return nutrients to farmlands for new food production.
